Delivery Information

- Orders should be placed before NOON the day before your scheduled delivery day so that we have time to assemble and load it on our delivery trucks.
- Trucks are loaded the afternoon before your delivery day; therefore, any changes to orders must be
 made before NOON the day before your scheduled delivery day. ENTIRE ORDER CANCELLATIONS MUST
 BE MADE BEFORE 8 AM the day before your scheduled delivery day.
- Delivery days change according to the season so please check with us or check the top of the inventory sheet for up to date information regarding which day we are sending a truck to your area.
- Orders are processed in the order they are received.
- Orders may be placed by phone, fax, email or <u>THE BEST WAY</u> by using our online inventory and ordering portal. Please give us a call or email us and we can send you a link and password.
- We will make all efforts to honor specific delivery requests (i.e. time, location, etc). However, our trucks are loaded with fuel and time in mind so that our drivers can make all of their stops efficiently. If your request cannot be honored we will let you know and give you our best estimate as to the time your order will be delivered. Our trucks have GPS tracking so, if you give us a call, we can give you timely updates as to the location of our drivers.
- All delivered orders will incur a fuel surcharge. Fuel surcharges change depending upon the cost of diesel fuel. Additional shipping charges may occur if the order does not meet a minimum for free delivery. Please contact us and we will let you know what these minimums are for your area.

PLANT SPACING CALCULATORS

We recommend planting 4" pots of bedding plants on 8-10" centers (the center of one plant to the center of the other). This spacing will allow for adequate air circulation and will allow the plants to grow in together creating a nice mass of color. Spacing can be greater for 4.5" and 6" pots or for spreading type plants like wave petunias.

BIDENS, Campfire (Flame & Marshmellow)

Vigorous and heat tolerant plant with flowers that bloom in the fall. It continuously blooms and reblooms. Deadheading is not necessary. Campfire attracts bees. It grows 12" tall in the garden and spreads up to 16" with a mounded habit. Plant in full sun in borders, containers and in mass landscape plantings.





BIDENS, Goldilocks Rocks

This long blooming, drought, heat and cold tolerant biden has huge flowers that have won 12 awards as a top performer in the garden. With bright golden flowers it fills the garden or containers with a mounding and trailing habit. Plant it in full sun. It will grow to about 12" in height and spread up to 20".

CALIBRACHOA, Superbells (Dreamsicle, Honeyberry & Tropical Sunrise)

In 2019 this calibrachoa won 11 awards for Top Performer. It's abundant, small petunia-like flowers are continuous bloomers with no deadheading necessary. It is both heat and cold tolerant. and attracts humming-birds. Plant it in full to part sun in well drained soil. It grows to a height of 10" and spreads up to 30" making it a great choice for both containers, hanging baskets and mass plantings in the garden.



GUARA, Karalee Petite Pink An annual that blooms from fall through spring and summer. Grow it in part sun to full. It's wands of pink flowers hover like butterflies over dark geen to burgundy foliage. It grow about 20" tall and 18" wide. Attracts butterflies.





JAMESBRITTENIA (Safari Dawn & Safari Dusk) This annual can bloom from fall through spring. Grow it in part sun to full sun in well drained soil. The newest member of the series, Safari Dusk, bears glitzy purple blooms with a gold eye. Safari Dawn, whose blossoms transition through rose pink and lavender shades while displaying a prominent yellow eye.

Both colors grow to a height of 12" and a width of 24".

LYSIMACHIA, Wakiki Sunset

The yellow-green foliage
on this plant is accented with yellow flowers in the fall. It's an
annual that is deer resistant. Easy to care for, it does not need
deadheading. It grows about 10" tall and spreads about 12" in
the garden. This plant can be planted in both sun or shade.





NEMESIA, SUNSATIA (Blood Orange, Coconut & Lemon)

This nemesia has colors ranging from glowing bright hues to the softest pastels. Sunsatia holds its own in both cold and hot temperatures, and is outstanding in hanging baskets, combos, and window boxes. This spreading plant can grow to a height of 14" and spread 16". Plant in part sun to full sun.







<u>SUPERTUNIA (Daybreak Charm, Persimmon and Picasso in Purple)</u>

Supertunias are extremely vigorous, mouding petunias that can reach up to 2 feet in height and trail up to 4 feet. They are fantastic landscape plants and are great in large containers. The continuously bloom in both heat and cold and are very drought tolerant. They attract both butterflies and hummingbirds. A good, all purpose fertilizer will keep supertunias looking spectacular all season long. They are also easily trimmed and put on new growth in about a week resulting in a fuller plant and even more blooms. Supertunias have won numerous awards for being Top Performers.







PHLOX, Intensia (Blueberry)

In 2010 and 2012 this Phlox won 19 awards for being a Top Performer in its class. Intensia attracts butterflies and is heat and cold tolerant. Plant it in full sun to part shade, but preferably in a spot that gets 4-6 hours of sun per day. The plant is self cleaning which means that no deadheading of flowers is necessary. It grows to a height of 16" and has a spread of up to 12" in the garden.

<u>VERBENA, Superbena (Cherryburst, Pink Cashmere, Sparkling Amethyst, Sparkling Rose & Stormburst)</u>

Superbenas have great vigor and wonderful performance. Its continuous blooming habit attracts bees and butterflies. It is also deer resistant. This verbena is very disease resistant. In 2023 Superbenas won 5 awards for being a Top Performer in its category. It grows to a height of up to 12" tall and spreads up to 30". Great for hanging baskets, planters and mass plantings in the garden in full sun to part sun.



ALYSSUM, Crystal

- Annua
- Blooms: Fall thru early spring
- Plant in full sun to light afternoon shade
- Deer resistant
- Height: 4" Spread: 12"
- Colors: Clear Mix and Clear White






AQUILEGIA (Columbine), Earlybird







Definitions

- Determinate: Bush type that bears it's fruit all at once & is usually more manageable in size
- Indeterminate: Vine type that continues to grow in length and keeps setting fruit throughout the season—needs staking

Disease Resistant Abbreviations

- V = Verticillium Wilt
- N = Nematodes
- F = Fusarium Wilt
- PM = Powdery Mildew
- FF = Fusarium, race 1 & 2
- A = Alternaria Stem Canker
- T = Tobacco Mosaic Virus
- St = Stemphyllum

Tips for a Successful Vegetable Garden

- Pick varieties that are recommended for your area and fit your garden size
- Place vegetables in a full sun location. It should be well drained but moisture retentive. A 2 inch layer of mulch will help retain water.
- Fertilize with a good, complete plant food
- Check the pH of your soil as different vegetables may require different levels of pH. An inexpensive test kit can be purchased at your local garden center or feed store
- Be aware of the spacing requirements for the different vegetables. Don't plant too closely.
- Water deeply, rather than often, to promote good root growth.







CHIVES "Garlic"

- Thin, flat leaves with garlic flavor
- Attractive white flowers in the
- Flowers are edible or make an attractive addition to bouquets



BASIL SWEET "Rutgers Obsession"

- Sweet large leaf basil
- Downey Mildew Resistant variety
- Medium dark green leaves
- Sweet scent and taste



CILANTRO (coriander)

- Foliage is cilantro: Seed is coriander
- Used in Mexican & Asian cooking
- Medicinal: Seed is a fungicidal & antibacterial



CATNIP

- Aromatic grey-green leaves
- Attractive scent to cats
- Mint flavor for salads or meats
- Medicinal & aromatherapy use
- Can be used to repel fleas



CITRONELLA BALM

- Culinary: Tea, salad, soups & stews
- Medicinal: Calms nerves
- Fragrance for: Potpourri & soaps
- Has double the oils of other balms



CELERY "Cutting"

- Used as herb & vegetable
- Slimmer stalks than regular celery
- Leaves resemble parsley
- Stronger than standard celery
- Use in soups, casseroles & salads



CURRY "Dwarf"

- Dwarf ornamental (not a culinary herb)
- Strong, curry smell
- Height: 10"
- Fragrant addition to gardens.



CHICORY

- Culinary: Roots & young shoots
- Medicinal: Diuretic, tonic & laxative properties. Said to protect the liver from excessive coffee drinking
- Ornamental: Lovely clear blue daisy flower.



CURRY "Tall"

- Ornamental (not usually a culinary herb)
- Strong, aromatic curry smell
- Height: 2'
- Medicinal: Oils are beneficial for bruises and varicose veins.



DTLL

- Fernlike herb has edible seeds & greens
- Popular additions to sauces & pickles
- Foliage is called "dillweed"
- Medicinal: Seeds are remedy for flatulence

FENNEL

- Feathery herb has sweet flavor
- Use leaves for salads, cole slaw & salad dressings
- Medicinal: Seeds used in teas for digestive aid



MINT "Swiss Spearmint"

- Commonly used in brewing tea
- Very vigorous & needs little care
- Leaves can be used fresh or dried.
- Smaller leaves than Spanish and Mint the Best.



LAVENDER

- Refreshing, clean aroma
- Silvery-gray foliage blooms violet shades
- Grow in a well drained soil
- Medicinal: Calming aroma; oils used in antibacterials & antiseptics



OREGANO "Greek"

- Most flavorful of all oreganos
- Culinary: bread, pizza, sauces, eggs, vegetables & seafood
- Medicinal: Teas for indigestion & coughs—oils for toothaches.



LEMON BALM

- Lemony flavor used in teas and salads
- Height: 2' in the garden
- Medicinal: Aerial parts used for teas for colds, flu, depression, headache, indigestion, sedation & anti-virals.



OREGANO "Hot & Spicy"

- Rounded leaves with pungent flavor and mild heat for pizza & Mexican.
- Culinary: fresh, dried or frozen
- Blooms with tiny pink flowers that attract bees & butterflies



MINT "Chocolate"

- Distinct chocolate mint aroma
- Can be dried and added to black tea
- Used as a garnish for chocolate desserts



OREGANO "Italian"

- Milder flavor than Greek Oregano
- Culinary: bread, pizza, sauces, eggs, vegetables & seafood. Use leaves fresh or dried.



MINT "The Best"

- Bright green aromatic leaves
- Has less menthol than other peppermints so it makes a great choice for using in mint sauces and in drinks



OREGANO "Variegated"

- Ornamental: borders, containers, edgings
- Culinary: salads, vegetables, salsa, meat dishes
- Fragrant; Attracts bees & butterflies.



MINT "Mojito Cuban"

- Original Cuban mint
- Most often used for making mojitos
- Use fresh or dried



PARSLEY "Curled"

- Ornamental, culinary & medicinal
- Use lush, curly plants as a border
- Tasty, rich in vitamins
- Breath purifying



MINT "Spanish Spearmint"

- Culinary & medicinal
- Leaves & flowers can be used raw or cooked
- Use in salads, added to cooked food or in teas



PARSLEY "Plain, Italian Flat Leaf"

- The standard for cooking
- Extremely nutritious
- Harvest as needed, but often, as the plants will keep sprouting new stems



ROSEMARY "Standard"

- Upright 3' tall variety
- · Leaves can be used fresh or dried
- High in iron, calcium & vitamin B6
- Use in all culinary practices



SORREL

- Low maintenance, leafy herb
- Tangy, pungent flavor resembling celery but richer and stronger
- Use in eggs, fish, soups or potato dishes
- Width: 1' Height: 1'



ROSEMARY "Barbecue"

- Large 48" tall variety
- Stems can be used as skewers for cooking on the grill releasing a very aromatic fragrance & add flavor to your meat.
- Use in the landscape as a filler



<u>TARRAGON</u> "Texas/Mexican" (early season only)

- Produces yellow, single marigold like flowers
- Harvest leaves as needed
- Perfect substitute for French tarragon which does not grow well in the South



ROSEMARY "Prostrate"

- Ornamental: Trailing, groundcover
- Culinary: Leaves can be used fresh or dried
- High in iron, calcium & vitamin B6



THYME "Lemon Variegated"

- Smells & tastes like lemon
- Use like regular thyme
- Variegated foliage makes it a perfect border plant for flower gardens or combo plantings



ROSEMARY "Spice Island"

- Ornamental: Bushy 5—6' tall and wide
- Culinary: Exceptional flavor fresh or dried
- Aromatic gray-green foliage



THYME "Mother of"

- The standard thyme for cooking
- Perennial plants spread vigorously to a spread of 2'
- Use: culinary or ornamental



ROSEMARY "Tuscan Blue"

- Ornamental: green foliage & violet blue flowers
- Attracts bees & butterflies
- Culinary: Lemony tang with pine flavor & scent. Use with chicken, lamb & fish.



THYME "Orange"

- Smells like orange
- Can be used in any dish that calls for thyme—fresh or dried
- Less trailing than other thyme varieties



SAGE "Garden"

- Slight peppery flavor
- Use for cheeses, poultry or pork stuffings, sausages and in Italian cooking.
- Perennial, evergreen subshrub



THYME "Silver Queen Lemon"

- Rich lemon scented leaves have thin silver margins
- Culinary: Use—fresh or dried
- Ornamental: Tiny, tubular, pale lilac flowers at the end of summer and attracts bees



SAGE "Tricolor"

- Unique variegated leaves
 - Use like normal garden sage but can also be used ornamentally



VERBENA "Lemon"

- Sweet lemon flavor
- Can be used in teas or desserts and as seasoning in meat dishes
- Semi hardy, shrubby perennial in protected areas
- Height: 6' Width: 8' (will not get this large in South Louisiana if not protected from frosts)
