Delivery Information

Orders should be placed before noon the day before your scheduled delivery day so that we have time to assemble and load it on our delivery trucks.

Trucks are loaded the afternoon before your delivery day so any changes to orders must be made before noon the day before.

- Delivery days change according to the season so please check with us or check the top of the inventory sheet for up to date information regarding which day we are sending a truck to your area.
- Orders are processed in the order they are received.
- Orders may be placed by phone, fax, email or by using our NowCommerce online real-time ordering portal.
- We will make all efforts to honor specific delivery requests (i.e. time, location, etc). However, our trucks are loaded with fuel and time in mind so that our drivers can make all of their stops in as efficient manner as possible. If your request cannot be honored we will let you know and give you our best estimate as to the time your order will be delivered. Our trucks have GPS tracking so, if you give us a call, we can give you timely updates as to the location of our drivers.
- All delivered orders will incur a fuel surcharge. Fuel surcharges change depending upon the cost of diesel fuel. Additional shipping charges may occur if the order does not meet a minimum for free delivery. Please contact us and we will let you know what these minimums are for your area.

PLANT SPACING CHART

We recommend that 4" pots of bedding plants be placed on 8 to 10 inch centers (the center of one plant to the center of the other). This spacing will allow for good air circulation around the plants and will allow the plants to grow together creating a nice mass of color. The spacing can be greater for 4.5" or 6" pots or for plants that spread rapidly such as Wave Petunias or Aztec Verbenas. For these types of plants, the spacing can be as great as 12" centers. We do not recommend spacing 4" bedding plants further than 10" centers as your garden will look rather sparce and the plants will never get large enough to fill in the area.

If it is necessary, because of budget constraints, to use 6 pack flats (36 plants per flat) of annuals you can choose to place 2 plants to a hole making the plant look as if a larger size has been used. The same number of flats can be used at less of a cost than using 4" or 6" pots and your results will still be beautiful.







Definitions

- Determinate: Bush type that bears it's fruit all at once & is usually more manageable in size
- Indeterminate: Vine type that continues to grow in length and keeps setting fruit throughout the season—needs staking
- F1 Hybrid: A variety bred by crossing 2 distinct parents to achieve certain characteristics like taste, uniformity and disease resistance. The plant is usually sterile and does not produce viable seeds.

- V = Verticillium Wilt
- N = Nematodes
- F = Fusarium Wilt
- PM = Powdery Mildew
- FF = Fusarium, race 1 & 2
- A = Alternaria Stem Canker
- T = Tobacco Mosaic Virus
- St = Stemphyllum

Tips for a Successful Vegetable Garden

- Pick varieties that are recommended for your area and fit your garden size
- Place vegetables in a full sun location. It should be well drained but moisture retentive. A 2 inch layer of mulch will help retain water.
- Fertilize with a good, complete plant food
- Check the pH of your soil as different vegetables may require different levels of pH. An inexpensive test kit can be purchased at your local garden center or feed store.
- When planting, be aware of the spacing requirements for the different vegetables. Don't plant too closely.
- Water deeply, rather than often, to promote good root growth.

- Days to Yield: 55 (determinate)
- Produces 1 1/4" round, red tomatoes
- Excellent for small gardens or containers
- Extra sweet red cherry type



TOMATO "Roma Italian"

- Days to Yield: 76 (determinate)
- Produces red plum fruit
- For canning or cooking—very meaty
- Resistance: F



WATERMELON "Crimson Sweet"

- Days to Yield: 85
- Produces 25 lb fruit
- Flesh is firm, red, fine textured & sweet.
- Resistance: F & anthracnose



ZUCCHINI "Spineless Beauty"

- Days to Yield: 43
- Produces 8" long zucchini
- Uniform, medium green fruit
- Resistance: Powdery Mildew

ANISE HYSSOP

- Use as bedding plant or edible flower
- Aromatic sweet licorice-mint flavor
- Flowers can be used fresh or dried
- Medicinal: aerial parts are energizing & cooling



<u>CATNIP</u>

- Aromatic grey-green leaves
- Attractive scent to cats
- Mint flavor for salads or meats
- Medicinal & aromatherapy use
- Can be used to repel fleas



ARUGULA "Wasabi"

- Smooth, broad, flat leaves with a crunchy, succulent consistency.
- Spicy, tangy bite with nutty, slightly bitter undertones
- Height: Averages 3"-6"
- Sidebar: Also produces edible, white flowers that have a sweet and nutty taste.



CELERY "Cutting"

- Used as herb & vegetable
- Slimmer stalks than regular celery
- Leaves resemble parsley
- Stronger than standard celery
- Use in soups, casseroles & salads



BASIL "African Blue"

- Sterile, perennial basil
- Aromatic strong camphor scent
- Leaves start purple & turn green
- Culinary or Ornamental



CHAMOMILE "German"

- Small, sweet smelling daisy flowers
- Medicinal: Tea made from the flowers aids in digestion & acts as a gentle sleep inducer



BASIL "Blue Spice"

- Spicy basil has hint of vanilla flavor
- Popular in beverages & baked goods
- Light purple flowers against purple bracts



CHICORY Wild

- Culinary: Roots & young shoots
- Medicinal: Diuretic, tonic & laxative properties. Said to protect the liver from excessive coffee drinking
- Ornamental: Lovely clear blue daisy flower.



BASIL "DMR Sweet Large Leaf"

- The standard for cooking
- DMR = Downey Mildew Resistant
- Large dark green leaves
- Sweet scent & taste
- Height: 24"



CHIVES

- Mild onion flavor
- Leaves are a key culinary herb
- Globe shaped blooms can be used as an edible garnish
- Can be used fresh or dried



CHIVES "Garlic"

- Thin, flat leaves with garlic flavor
- Attractive white flowers in the summer
- Flowers are edible or make an attractive addition to bouquets



CILANTRO (coriander)

- Foliage is cilantro: Seed is coriander
- Used in Mexican & Asian cooking
- Medicinal: Seed is a fungicidal & antibacterial



CITRONELLA BALM

- Culinary: Tea, salad, soups & stews
- Medicinal: Calms nerves
- Potpourri & soaps
- Very fragrant
- Has double the oils of other balms



CULANTRO (aka fitweed)

- Native to: Mexico, S America & Carribean
- Very intense cilantro aroma & flavor
- Use in dishes where regular cilantro would be too delicate such as beef & chicken stews or rice & beans.



CURRY "Dwarf"

- Dwarf ornamental (not a culinary herb)
- Strong, aromatic curry smell
- Height: 10"
- Fragrant addition to gardens or containers



CURRY "Tall"

- Ornamental (not usually a culinary herb)
- Strong, aromatic curry smell
- Height: 2'
- Medicinal: Oils are beneficial for bruises and varicose viens



DILL

- Fernlike herb has edible seeds & greens
- Popular additions to sauces & pickles
- Foliage is called "dillweed"
- Medicinal: Seeds are remedy for flatulence



FENNEL

- Feathery herb has sweet flavor
- Use leaves for salads, cole slaw & salad dressings
- Medicinal: Seeds used in teas for digestive aid



LAVENDER

- Refreshing, clean aroma
- Silvery-gray foliage blooms violet shades
- Grow in a well drained soil
- Medicinal: Calming aroma; oils used in antibacterials & antiseptics



LEMON BALM

- Lemony flavor used in teas and salads
- Height: 2' in the garden
- Medicinal: Aerial parts used for teas for colds, flu, depression, headache, indigestion, sedation & antivirals



MINT "Chocolate"

- Distinct chocolate mint aroma
- Can be dried and added to black tea
- Used as a garnish for chocolate desserts



MINT "Ginger"

- Distinct ginger aroma
- Used as a seasoning for fruits & vegetables
- Dried leaves for potpourris



MINT "Kentucky Colonel"

- Bright green aromatic leaves
- Should be grown in a pot
- Although used for mint juleps, this mint can be used in any recipe calling for spearmint including mint sauce and mint jelly.



OREGANO "Greek"

- Most flavorful of all oreganos
- Culinary: bread, pizza, sauces, eggs, vegetables & seafood
- Medicinal: Teas for indigestion & coughs—oils for toothaches



MINT "The Best"

- Bright green aromatic leaves
- Has less menthol than other peppermints so it makes a great choice for using in mint sauces and in drinks



OREGANO "Hot & Spicy"

- Rounded leaves with pungent flavor and mild heat
- Culinary: fresh, dried or frozen
- Great for Mexican dishes & pizza
- Blooms with tiny pink flowers that attract bees & butterflies



MINT "Mojito Cuban"

- The original Cuban mint!
- Bright green, large, aromatic leaves
- Scent & flavor are mild & warm—not pungent or overly sweet



OREGANO "Italian"

- Milder flavor than Greek Oregano
- Culinary: bread, pizza, sauces, eggs, vegetables & seafood. Use leaves fresh or dried



MINT "Orange"

- Unique citrus aroma & flavor
- Leaves are high in vitamin A & C
- Use in salads, desserts, garnishes, mint sauce, mint jelly & mint vinegar



PARSLEY "Curled"

- Ornamental, culinary & medicinal
- Use lush, curly plants as a border
- Tasty, rich in vitamins
- Breath purifying



MINT "Peppermint"

- Mint for flavoring candy, gum & other sweets
- Harvest young leaves for culinary purposes
- Has a cool aftertaste



PARSLEY "Plain, Italian Flat

- The standard for cooking
- Extremely nutritious
- Harvest as needed, but often, as the plants will keep sprouting new stems



MINT "Spanish Spearmint"

- Culinary & medicinal
- Leaves & flowers can be used raw or cooked
- Use in salads, added to cooked food or in teas



PINEAPPLE SAGE

- Fruit scented fragrance
- Height: 2'
- Perfect garnish for teas, frosty drinks or fruity desserts
- Blooms with red flower



MINT "Swiss Spearmint"

- Commonly used in brewing tea
- Very vigorous & needs little care
- Leaves can be used fresh or dried



ROSEMARY "Standard"

- Upright 3' tall variety
- Leaves can be used fresh or dried
- High in iron, calcium & vitamin B6
- Use in all culinary practices



ROSEMARY "Barbecue"

- Large 48" tall variety
- Stems can be used as skewers for cooking on the grill and will release a very aromatic fragrance & add flavor to your meat
- Use in the landscape as a filler



STEVIA

- 300 times the sweetness of sugar
- Natural sweetener for people on carbohydrate controlled diets
- Medical research has shown possible benefits in treating obesity & high blood pressure



ROSEMARY "Prostrate"

- Ornamental: Trailing, groundcover
- Culinary: Leaves can be used fresh or dried
- High in iron, calcium & vitamin B6



TARRAGON "Texas/Mexican"

- Produces yellow, single marigold like flowers
- Harvest leaves as needed
- Perfect substitute for French tarragon which does not grow well in the South



ROSEMARY "Spice Island"

- Ornamental: Bushy 5—6' tall and wide
- Culinary: Exceptional flavor fresh or dried
- Aromatic gray-green foliage



THYME "Lemon Variegated"

- Smells & tastes like lemon
- Use like regular thyme
- Variegated foliage makes it a perfect border plant for flower gardens or combo plantings



ROSEMARY "Tuscan Blue"

- Ornamental: Sea green foliage & violet blue flowers
- Attracts bees & butterflies
- Culinary: Lemony tang with pine flavor & scent. Use with chicken, lamb & fish



THYME "Mother of"

- The standard thyme for cooking
- Perennial plants spread vigorously to a spread of 2'
- Use: culinary or ornamental



SAGE "Garden"

- Slight peppery flavor
- Use for cheeses, poultry or pork stuffings, sausages and in Italian cooking
- Perennial, evergreen subshrub



THYME "Orange"

- Smells like orange
- Can be used in any dish that calls for thyme—fresh or dried
- Less trailing than other thyme varie-

- Vigorous
- Refreshing fragrance
